


## SECS Network Drive

Your SECS Network Drive is mounted as your H: drive on any SECS domain computer (including [computer labs](#)). It is also your home directory when you connect to a SECS Linux Server. You can connect to your SECS Network Drive from a non-domain computer using the instructions below.

Faculty have a 50 Gigabyte storage limit, and students have a 30 Gigabyte storage limit. Network Drives are backed up weekly and will be held until 3 months after your SECS account is disabled. To request a larger quota contact [secs@oakland.edu](mailto:secs@oakland.edu). There is no disaster recovery guarantee or off site backup.

### How To Connect to the SECS Network Drive

 **Note:** Accessing the SECS Network Drive from off campus or over GrizzNet requires the user to connect to the [SECS VPN](#) first.

#### Windows

1. Open [File Explorer](#)
2. Type: `\\dione.secs.oakland.edu\YourUserName` (replace YourUserName)
3. Login with your SECS username and password.

#### Linux

1. Open [Nautilus](#)
2. Select File then connect to Server
3. Choose the Following options


```
Service Type: "Windows Share"  
Server: dione.secs.oakland.edu  
Share: YourUserName  
Folder: <BLANK>  
User Name: YourUSerName  
Domain Name: SECS
```

4. Click Connect
5. Enter your password when prompted.

## Mac OSX

1. Open [Finder](#)
2. Select “Go” from the Menu Bar
3. Choose “Connect to Server”
4. In the Server Address bar type smb://dione.secs.oakland.edu/YourUserName (replace YourUserName)
5. Select “Registered User”
6. Login with your SECS username and password
7. Select “Connect”

## Alternative Methods to Connect to Your SECS Network Drive

 **Note:** Accessing the SECS Network Drive from off campus requires the user to connect to the [SECS VPN](#) first.

Use the [VPN web portal](#) and click the Network Drive link after you log in. This will require authentication. The Domain is: SECS

Use a SCP client such as winSCP to connect to login.secs.oakland.edu.
